

# STORMWATER MANAGEMENT: FOOD SERVICE

Stormdrains on campus deposit any and all liquids directly into the Campus Lagoon and Pacific Ocean. Anything other than rainwater is prohibited and is the cause of water pollution. Only rain down the stormdrain!



**DO NOT:** Hose down spills.

**DO:** Stop spills at their source to prevent entrance into stormdrains. Use dry methods for cleanup (sweeping, cat litter, etc.).

**DO NOT:** Dispose of grease in dumpsters, trash cans, or stormdrains.

**DO:** Recycle grease in separate containers.



**DO NOT:** Place solid waste in uncovered or leaky dumpsters.

**DO:** Always close lids, and inspect dumpsters often. Ask your hauler to make necessary repairs.

**DO NOT:** Pour wash water out onto a parking lot, alley, sidewalk, or street.

**DO:** Pour wash water into a janitorial or mop sink.
