## How to Use a Fire Extinguisher

**Summary:** Follow these instructions for using a portable fire extinguisher.

W	/hat to do	How to do it
1	Sound the alarm.	<ul> <li>a. Activate the fire alarm and call for help.</li> <li>On campus telephones call Campus Police at 9-911.</li> <li>Non-campus telephone call 9-1-1.</li> <li>b. Tell people in the area to evacuate.</li> </ul>
2	Determine if it is safe to use a fire extinguisher.	<ul> <li>a. Use a fire extinguisher only if:</li> <li>The fire is small.</li> <li>You know how to use a fire extinguisher.</li> <li>You have a clear exit path behind you.</li> </ul>
3	Use the <b>P-A-S-S</b> procedures.	• Hold the extinguisher within six feet of the fire.  Pull the pin located in the extinguisher's handle.
		Aim the nozzle, horn, or hose at the base of the fire.  Squeeze (or press) the handles together.
		Sweep from side to side at the base of the fire until it is out.
	Follow up as needed.	<ul> <li>a. Report used extinguishers immediately.</li> <li>On campus: Environmental Health &amp; Safety, ext.7751.</li> <li>b. If any injuries or damage occurred please call Risk Management, ext. 2860.</li> <li>d have a question about fire safety, contact the UCSB Deputy Fire</li> </ul>

**Notice:** In case of fire, your first responsibility is to escape unharmed and sound the alarm. Use a fire extinguisher only if you have been trained to use one and you have a clear exit path behind you.
