STORMWATER MANAGEMENT: LANDSCAPING

<u>Stormdrains on campus deposit any and all liquids directly into the Campus Lagoon and Pacific Ocean.</u>

<u>Anything other than rainwater is prohibited and is the cause of water pollution. Only rain down the stormdrain!</u>



DO NOT: Adopt a "chemicals only" approach to pest control. **DO**: Utilize an Integrated Pest Management system. This includes a primary focus on physical controls, then biological controls, then chemical controls as a last resort.


DO NOT: Blow, sweep, rake or hose yard waste into the street.

DO: Recycle leaves, grass clippings and other yard waste.



DO NOT: Cause run-off by over watering the landscape.

DO: Water just enough to soak into the ground, conserve water by controlling the amount of flow and direction of sprinkler heads.



DO: Spot apply fertilizers and pesticides only as needed.
