INSTRUCTIONS

Use the Request for Mexican Automobile Insurance form to obtain Mexican automobile insurance when traveling to Mexico in a UC Santa Barbara vehicle. Mexican law requires that U.S. citizens who drive vehicles into Mexico must carry Mexican automobile insurance. Complete a Request for Mexican Automobile Insurance and submit it to UCSB Risk Management for any UC Santa Barbara vehicle being taken to Mexico.

PROCESSING THE REQUEST

- 1) Complete Request for Mexican Automobile Insurance form; Department control point must review, approve, and sign Request.
- 2) Submit completed Request to UCSB Risk Management for review and approval.
- 3) UCSB Risk Management will fax approved Request to MacAfee & Edwards.
- 4) UCSB Risk Management will also prepare an Authorization to Drive UC Vehicle in Mexico letter and fax or mail it to Department.
- 5) MacAfee & Edwards will prepare Mexican auto liability insurance policy for vehicle and fax or mail policy and invoice to Department.
- 6) Employee must carry the Mexican auto insurance policy and the Authorization to Drive UC Vehicle in Mexico letter in vehicle.

U.S. citizens driving in Mexico are subject to Mexican laws. The laws in Mexico that govern the operation of a motor vehicle are different than those in the States. Even a minor vehicle accident in Mexico can have serious consequences. In the event of an accident, the extent to which you will be able to deal with the problems that will arise will rely on the precautions you take and the planning you do before you leave.
