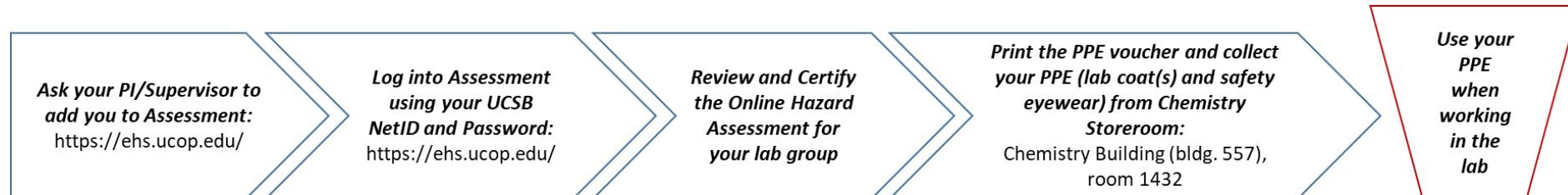


Steps to Obtain Free Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):



UC Personal Protective Equipment Policy Requires:

1. Assess and document the hazards of the work place (by using the online application [Assessment](#))
2. Provide to each lab member PPE at no cost;
3. Provide documented training on proper PPE use and maintenance;
4. Provide free method for workers to clean/sanitize their PPE ([free laundry program](#));
5. The minimum PPE requirements for entering a laboratory are long pants or equivalent and closed toe shoes. When one engages in hazardous activity or when in close proximity to hazards lab coat and safety eyewear are required.

Additional PPE Programs

1. **PPE Recycling program**- we collect unwanted lab coats/eye wear for laundry/wash and re-use. Just look for the black bins labeled with "PPE Recycling" at each laundry location.
2. **PPE Loaner Program** for individuals only working for short periods on campus.
