## Safe Work Procedure Checklist:

## 1. PRE-Operation:

- Task (e.g. Drawings, instructions, specifications etc) is clearly understood.
- The appropriate disk is correctly in place.
- Work piece is securely clamped.
- Ensure guarding is in place on grinder.
- Identify ON/OFF switch.

## 2. Operation:

- Check that the disk runs 'true' and does not wobble.
- Keep hands clear of work piece and away from disk.
- Turn off machine at power point before changing the disk.
- Guarding in place before machine re-start.
- Machines must be isolated from power sources when being cleaned, adjusted, maintained or repaired.

## **POST-Operation:**

- Switch off grinder before removing waste material from the bench.
- Make sure disk is still in good condition before putting away.
